Code blue: 'Doctors to the Barrios' return to service program keeps healthcare system alive amid worker shortage

A new generation of doctors is poised to revitalize the Philippine healthcare system following the March 2026 Physician Licensure Examination. With 1,954 exam passers as new physicians, the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) highlights an incoming workforce equipped to address gaps in public healthcare, especially in marginalized communities.

Yet, beneath the optimism lies a stark reality: a public health system in dire need of professionals to deliver life-saving services to the country's most remote and underserved communities.

Universally, a hospital "code blue" indicates a medical emergency where a patient is experiencing a life-threatening emergency. In these critical seconds, nearby medical personnel work together to revive a patient. Strict protocol, precise movement, and a heartbeat are what separate a patient from life and death.

Yet, despite life-saving abilities, the public health system remains understaffed. Very few hands are available to help care for millions of patients, especially in rural areas and island towns in need of medical care.

Dr. Brittany Mandalihan, Universal Healthcare Outcomes Manager for the Department of Health (DOH)-CALABARZON, paints a harrowing picture: a country facing a shortage of health workers, with those who remain being stretched dangerously thin.

"Medyo nakakalungkot man po at matagal na po nating problema ang usapin pagdating sa mga healthcare worker. Batay sa datos ng ating rehiyon, masasabi namin na hindi pa rin talaga sapat ang bilang ng ating healthcare workers hindi lang sa ating rehiyon pero pati na rin sa ating bansa lalo na sa mga primary care facility at rural health units."

Globally, the World Health Organization (WHO) recommends a ratio of 10 doctors for every 10,000 population—or one doctor for every 1,000 population. However, the DOH operates with fewer resources, targeting one (1) doctor for every 20,000

population. For nurses, the ratio is one for every 10,000 population; 1:5,000 for midwives, and 1:50,000 for dentists.

Despite being already below global standards, the health department records reveal massive significant shortages in healthcare personnel. Public health facilities such as Rural Health Units and Primary Care Facilities are short of at least 2,000 physicians, 4,400 nurses, and 3,900 midwives. Even public dental services were not spared with close to 140 shortages.

Catering to a fast-growing population, the Philippines is very well aware of its depleting supply of healthcare professionals. A study by the Ateneo de Manila University highlighted the country's perennial problem of shortages of nurses and physicians.

"Government primary care facilities and hospitals struggle to hire sufficient staff due to budget and policy barriers, while private hospitals struggle to keep their staff due to fiscal complaints."

Healthcare workers were not exempt in the country's "brain drain" phenomenon, which sees skilled professionals migrate for better compensation and work conditions. Instead of expanding the workforce, fresh graduates have become a quick fix for the ongoing shortage. Without tenured and experienced professionals to mentor them, new graduates were ill-prepared for deployment.

The DOH admits that it cannot force healthcare workers to stay in the country, choosing instead to strengthen its human resource-centered programs. Initiatives such as the National Health Workers' Support System and the Doctors to the Barrios program aim to deploy specialists into public health facilities and last-mile communities.

"Tayo ay nagbibigay sa mga city at probinsya ng nurses, midwife, medtech, therapist, dentist, and nutritionists. Isa na rin sa mga programa natin ay 'yung Doctors to the Barrios program kung saan 'yung mga munisipyo na walang doktor ay binibigyan natin ng mga doktor. Usually ito 'yung

scholars natin na pinag-aaral ng medisina at sila po ay nagre-return to service for three years after nila mag-aral."

Currently, 38 physicians under the Doctors to the Barrios program are catering to 236 barangays across 52 municipalities in the region that are considered Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA).

"Ang ating Department of Health ay mayroong post-residency placement program sa mga government hospital, at after nila makapasa sa kanilang exams ay kailangan nilang magbigay ng one year na return service sa mga lugar kung saan sila ide-deploy."

Additionally, the DOH Post-Residency Placement Program binds recent graduates to a one-year service in remote and underserved government hospitals as a return service. This model has been vital in Quezon province where a delicate healthcare system must constantly adapt to isolated communities and a parade of calamities.

Quezon Governor Helen Tan said the provincial government is sponsoring 33 scholars who are taking medicine courses. As part of their return service program, these doctors will serve Quezon's remote communities without access to healthcare services.

"May 33 na pinag-aaral ng pagdu-doktor ang kapitolyo, libre po iyon. Para 'yung mga lugar na walang doktor ay magkadoktor dahil may return of service po iyon."

More than simply 'giving back' to the community, the return service program seeks to augment its health services with specialized doctors, such as occupational and speech therapists.

Health officials openly acknowledge that mandated service is a short term fix in the gaps in the healthcare system. But as long as local offerings pale in comparison to lucrative overseas compensation, the Philippine public health sector will remain a revolving door for trained professionals. NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED, that:

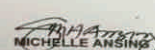

DOST Ilocos Region Empowers TESDA RO1 Information Officers through Expert-Led Training on Photography, Photojournalism, Reels Making

The Department of Science and Technology Ilocos Region (DOST Ilocos Region), under the leadership of Regional Director Teresita A. Tabao, served as resource speakers during the "Capturing Stories through the Lens: Basic Photography and Photojournalism Training" organized by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority Regional Office No. 1 (TESDA RO1), headed by Regional Director Ramon Evan T. Ruiz, held on May 19–20, 2026 at the TESDA Regional Office I.

More than simply teaching participants how to take photos, the training emphasized the power of photography and storytelling in documenting realities, preserving moments, and communicating stories that matter.

As part of the second day of the workshop, Mr. Lemuel G. Castigo, Science Research Specialist I, and Karl Anthony M. Bugar, Project Technical Assistant II, shared their expertise in photography, visual storytelling, photojournalism, and mobile content creation

through engaging discussions and hands-on activities.

The activity equipped participants with practical knowledge on camera handling, composition techniques, lighting principles, visual storytelling, ethical documentation, and mobile reels creation — essential skills in today's fast-paced digital communication landscape.

Mr. Bugar first discussed the technical foundations of photography, including camera basics and functions, proper handling



of camera settings, composition techniques, and lighting principles. He also highlighted the importance of understanding the Exposure Triangle — aperture, shutter speed, and ISO — as the heart of every well-crafted image.

"Ang Exposure Triangle ang pinaka-basic foundation ng photography. Mas mahalagang maintindihan ito dahil dito nagsisimula ang tamang pagkuha at pag-control ng bawat shot. At kung walang light, walang photo — ganoon lang kasimple ang photography," Mr. Bugar explained.

Participants were introduced to the science behind capturing images and how proper control of light, timing, and composition can transform ordinary shots into compelling photographs.

Following the photography session, Mr. Castigo discussed the fundamentals of photojournalism and visual storytelling, emphasizing that powerful photographs are not only technically good — they



should also tell meaningful stories.

"Anyone can take a photo. But not everyone can tell a story in one frame. Kaya mula ngayon, huwag lang tayong basta magpicture. Mag-document. Magkuwento at mag-capture ng mga moments na may meaning," he shared.

He further discussed the importance of ethical storytelling, identifying impactful shots, caption writing using the Five Ws, proper documentation, and creating engaging reels using mobile phones to effectively communicate stories to the public.

The workshop became more dynamic as participants applied the concepts through practical shooting exercises, output presentations, and

interactive critiquing sessions where creativity, technical skills, and storytelling were put into action behind every frame.

More than a technical training, the activity served as a reminder that photography is a powerful tool for communication and public service — one that can capture reality, amplify stories, and preserve moments that inspire communities.

Through initiatives like this, DOST Ilocos Region continues to strengthen partnerships with regional agencies by sharing knowledge and technical expertise in communication, media, and digital content development anchored on science, technology, and innovation.
